

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

1. CHECK THE CLASS IN WHICH THE TRADE MARK CAN BE REGISTERED; -

When registering a trademark you need to specify the products and services that will be associated with your trademark. In India all products and services classified into 45 classes -- 35 for products, 10 for services -- permitting you to specify precise and clear classes covering your trademark. The protection that is offered to a registered trademark covers only the classes specified at the time of registration, therefore, allowing two identical trademarks to coexist in distinct classes. The agencies governments are in charge of the registration of trademarks for a given class, offering greater protection and greater investment.

2. NAME SEARCH ;-

This include a report contain the similar or identical name. A Company cannot use the same name or closely similar name of another existing trademark in India. This report is optional but highly recommended because it allow you to rule out any possible objection to your trademark in advance. A name treated a undesirable if it is :

- A. Close phonetic resemble of an existing Trade Mark
- B. If It contain common name like State name, god name, country name etc
- C. If it is different by the existing trade mark merely by addition/deletion of world like Nav, New, Modern etc.

3. OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Power of Attorney
- 2. Form TM-1 in triplicate for Department
- 3. Additional Representations in five copies
- 4. Pay Order/Demand Draft of Rs. 2500/- in favour of "The Registrar of Trade Mark" payable at New Delhi for each class
- 5. Name/Image of proposed Trade Mark in 10 copies (match box size)
